Term 3 learning

English- We are reading "George's Marvellous Medicine" by Roald Dahl. Our unit focusses on factual writing with an emphasis on procedures.

Mathematics- Whole Numbers, Two-Dimensional Space, Addition and Subtraction, Multiplication and Division, Chance, Fractions and Decimals, Mass and Position

Mappen Unit (Science) -Robot buddies

Students will work in groups to design and build a robot using craft materials. They will learn about the properties of different materials and consider which materials they should use to build their robot. Students will practise striving for accuracy as they design and build new objects and write instructions for others to follow. They will practise thinking creatively and imaginatively as they use different strategies to modify existing products.
